Quality Care Counts

Your satisfaction matters to us! For many years, Marian Community Hospital has engaged in an active process of soliciting feedback from patients about their healthcare experiences. During this past year, Marian Community Hospital participated in the Patient Experience Survey designed and managed by the National Research Corporation (NRC) of Lincoln, Nebraska. Known as “The Leader in Healthcare Performance Measurement,” NRC randomly mails surveys to a select number of individuals following an inpatient stay, surgery or Emergency Department visit. Survey results are provided on a daily and quarterly basis. The Patient Satisfaction and Measurement Committee of Values In Practice is comprised of staff from various hospital departments. St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing - Reunion Set for April 1, 2006



Not long after St. Joseph's Hospital was founded, local officials recognized the need to educate nurses in order to adequately staff the growing hospital. Their answer to the nursing shortage of the 1920's was simple; if you need nurses, open a School of Nursing.

By 1929, the first class of eleven students graduated from St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing. The School continued to attract and educate highly qualified students interested in the nursing vocation until the last graduating class in 1978. In total, more than 850 students received a nursing diploma from St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing.

Where does it all go?

- \$200,640** - Upgrade of the hospital wide fire alert system and fire panel to ensure the safety of our patients, visitors, and employees.
- \$14,900** - Tractor for our dedicated maintenance department to keep all walkways and parking lots free of snow and ice to ensure patient and visitor safety.
- \$7,615** - Refurbishing and relocation of the Sleep Lab to the fourth floor for enhanced patient comfort and privacy.
- \$7,381** - Creation of the new Wound Care Center, treating hard to heal wounds with the power of oxygen.

Advanced Healing

With over 30 patients treated, the recently opened Wound Care Center at Marian Community Hospital is experiencing great success. Patients receive treatment in a special hyperbaric oxygen chamber which aids the healing process by the inhalation of pure oxygen under increased atmospheric pressure. Heart Healthy



Through the generosity of the Marian Community Hospital Auxiliary, the hospital is in the process of acquiring a Transesophageal Transducer. The Transducer, when used in conjunction with an echocardiogram machine, allows a cardiologist to look at the heart from a tube that is passed into the esophagus. This test provides clearer images of the heart which can help detect various cardiac conditions,

injuries, and other types of heart disease with more accuracy.

Patient Safety is Our #1 Priority

A new fire detection system has been installed throughout Marian Community Hospital. The system consists of a main fire panel, notification alarms and smoke detectors. The computerized system allows hospital security to monitor the system from the security office. If a detector senses smoke, a horn sounds and the fire panel flashes indicating the area of the fire. The system also sends an immediate message to the Carbondale Fire Department. Sleep Lab Open House

Two beautifully appointed sleep rooms have been added on the fourth floor. Sleep studies are conducted during the typical sleeping
